1. **Questions**

- a. **Q:** Would RQAW entertain paying for stored material?  
**A:** RQAW has accepted pay applications for stored materials in the recent past. We are willing to work with the selected contractor on this and do what is most appropriate!
- b. **Q:** Would RQAW allow for a revised schedule of values to bill from that would identify more specific items of work?  
**A:** Bids are to be based off the drawings. If the contractor would like to provide an additional schedule of values based on items included in individual contract items, and keep track of any deviation from the drawings for final adjustment of payment, that is acceptable. However, pay applications will need to reflect the bid items present on the bid form.
- c. **Q:** For meter changeouts, are the replacements to include the setters?  
**A:** Replacements should only include new setters in the event that the new meter will not fit into the existing setter. For the purpose of the bid, contractors should include setter costs for

anticipated changeouts requiring setters. However, the current operator did note that all setters in town are the same.
